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SC reserves verdict on whether to refer to larger bench the decision in "Nabam Rebia vs Deputy Speaker"

New Delhi, Feb 16 (UNI) : Supreme Court's five-judge Constitution bench on Thursday reserves its verdict on whether to refer the cases related to the Maharashtra political crisis to a larger seven-judge or nine-judge bench for reconsideration.

In 2016 Nabam Rebia case, the five-judge Constitution bench of the Supreme Court, had held that Speaker cannot initiate disqualification proceedings when a resolution seeking his removal is pending.

Senior advocate Kapil Sibal appearing for Uddhav Thackeray camp submitted that there is an imperative need to reconsider the law laid down in Nabam Rebia case. "It's time for us to relook at Nabam Rebia and the 10th Schedule because it has created havoc," Sibal has said.

Sibal sought a direction for reference to a larger bench for reconsideration of the 2016 judgement by a seven-judge bench.

Senior advocate Neeraj Kishan Kaul, appearing for Eknath Shinde group said, there was no need for a reference of Rebia judgement to a larger bench.

Senior advocate Harish Salve, also for Shinde group, said anti defection law is not a weapon for a leader who has lost faith. "There are layers of political morality in all of this and it is best the court stay away from all of this, these are complex questions," he said, maintaining that anti defection law can not be used as anti-dissent law.

Opposing the plea for reference, Salve said there are delicate constitutional issues which arose on case to case basis and dealt with. Referring to facts of the case, he said, on June 28, former Maharashtra CM Thackeray was asked to prove his majority on the floor of the House. On June 29, Sunil Prabhu, chief whip moved this court asking stay of this session, the Supreme Court declined it and Thackeray subsequently resigned.

He also contended Rebia judgement had no role in the events that transpired in the state. In his submission, Solicitor General Tushar Mehta said the contention by Thackeray faction that the observations in Nabam Rebia provided an escape route to "constitutional sinners" and that the judgement failed to consider the possibility of misuse for avoidance of disqualification proceedings by mere issuance of notice for removal of the Speaker, is wholly unsustainable.

A three-judge bench had on August 23, 2022 referred the matter to the Constitution bench after framing first issue whether notice for removal of a Speaker restricts him from continuing with disqualification proceedings under Tenth Schedule of the Constitution, as held by this court in Nabam Rebia case.

Thackeray's Shiv Sena had suffered a blow after Shinde and other MLAs ousted their leader as the Chief Minister of Maharashtra.

Uddhav Thackeray faction of Shiv Sena sought that five-judge Nabam Rebia case be referred to seven judge bench for reconsideration.

Engineer who hacks Mumbai police verification system arrested

Mumbai, Feb 16 (UNI) : Mumbai police have arrested an Uttar Pradesh-based civil engineer who had hacked Mumbai Police passport verification system to get his wife's passport approved.

Accused identified as Babu Shah was arrested by the Mumbai Police crime branch from from Ghaziabad, had used system with Noida's IP address.

According to police Shah wanted to impress his wife who harboured a dream of getting job abroad. His plans tanked when his wife's passport didn't get approval during the verification.

The engineer then decided to take matters in his own hands. He then ideated to hack the Mumbai police's system to approve his wife's passport application.

The police were quoted saying that in spite of having no discrepancies, the applicant's passport was halted after initial investigation by the authorities. The police added that he also approved a couple more applications to avoid suspicion.

According to the official press statement here on Thursday stated that, Mr. Bais will arrive at

Mumbai airport on Friday evening and will be received by dignitaries including Chief Minister Eknath Shinde. Newly appointed Governor Mr Bais is a respected name in erstwhile Madhya Pradesh and present state of Chhattisgarh as well as national politics. With a long experience of five decades in parliamentary

politics, social causes and organization work, Mr. Bais has ably performed various responsibilities in public life from the post of corporator to the post of Union Minister of State and Governor.

Born on August 2, 1947 in Raipur (Chhattisgarh) and was educated in Raipur. He served as a member of the budget committee of the Madhya Pradesh legislature and then as a member of the library committee. He was also the state minister of Madhya Pradesh Bharatiya Janata Party from 1982 to 1988. In the year 1989, Mr Bais was first elected to the Lok Sabha from Raipur. Since then he has been elected to the Lok Sabha as many as six times, i.e. a total of seven times. In the year 1998, he was appointed as Minister of State in the Ministry of Steel and Mines in the Cabinet of Prime Minister Atal Bihari Vajpayee. In 1999 to 2004, he served as Minister of State for Chemicals and Fertilizers and then as Minister of State for Information and Broadcasting.
